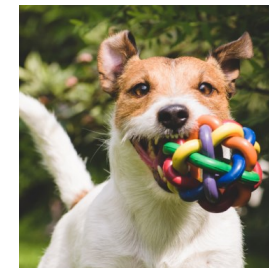




# Puppy Programme



We, at My Doggy Daycare, have a full programme dedicated to give puppies the best start in life. We focus on ensuring that puppies in our care grow up to be happy and friendly around other dogs and people. Our programme is designed to ensure that each pup has a stimulating and enriching experience at doggy daycare whilst under expert supervision at all times. We provide a safe and loving environment where puppies can focus on socialisation and basic training, learning valuable new skills to aid their development. We closely monitor all our puppies progress and identify and address any issues before they become bigger problems.

A typical week on our puppy programme is provided below. These activities are included as part of their normal day in which they will be socialising and playing with other dogs (including adult dogs) under strict supervision. Activities are constantly rotated so that each puppy has a chance to participate in each activity regardless of the day they come. At all times during the day we reinforce training with a focus on; building good socialisation skills with other dogs, basic obedience, manners in meeting people, and reduced barking (if your pup is prone to using their voice)!
